## A FEW WORDS

More than 50 years ago we ate with, slept shoulder to shoulder with, fought with, and served with those who fought a vicious war. From May 5 to May 7, 2026, we will once again be able to meet with those same outstanding Marines and Marine Corpsmen, who shared with us the most profound times of our lives. They were patriotic heroes who stepped up for their country, rather than run away North to another. They were from all parts of this great country. Whether they liked that war or not they did their duty and can stand proud of it. Once over there they did not fight so much for their country, but for the men who stood beside them. They tried to protect those around them, and in doing so were often protected themselves. Their reasons for being there were many, to help the South Vietnamese people, to stop a Communist takeover of another country, and to serve their own country or for other personal reasons.

Now we have the chance to meet again with many of those men from 1/7, face to face. To share our stories, to get answers to things that happened so many years ago. To renew old friendships and make new ones with great men. I for one knew very few men from 1/7 in Vietnam. My squad and maybe a dozen or so others. But now I know many, not only from my own company but from all the others with 1/7. Men who I can now call my brothers.

We had roughly 6,000 men who served with 1/7, 65-70. We have found nearly all of them. If we add the 566, that we lost in Nam to those we know that have died since returning, we are less than half that full number. Many returned via a medivac and their war ended abruptly. Some of those have lived with serious major injuries. They seek answers to what happened after they left. Some lost friends after returning home, how and why did they die?

The war for us is over. Many can still not let go of it. But a 1/7 reunion has helped many who served with 1/7. Be at the reunion, not just yourself, but for those who want to see you again. Maybe you can help give answers to some of those lingering questions. There is no one on this earth, who you can talk with better, than someone who was there with you.

Individual room reservations may be cancelled without penalty outside of 72 hours prior to arrival. Cancellation within 72 hours of scheduled arrival will result in a 1 night's room and tax charge.
